## **Activities and Programs**

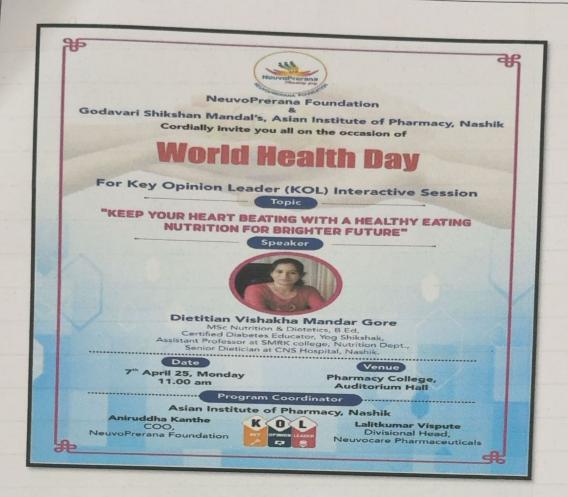
