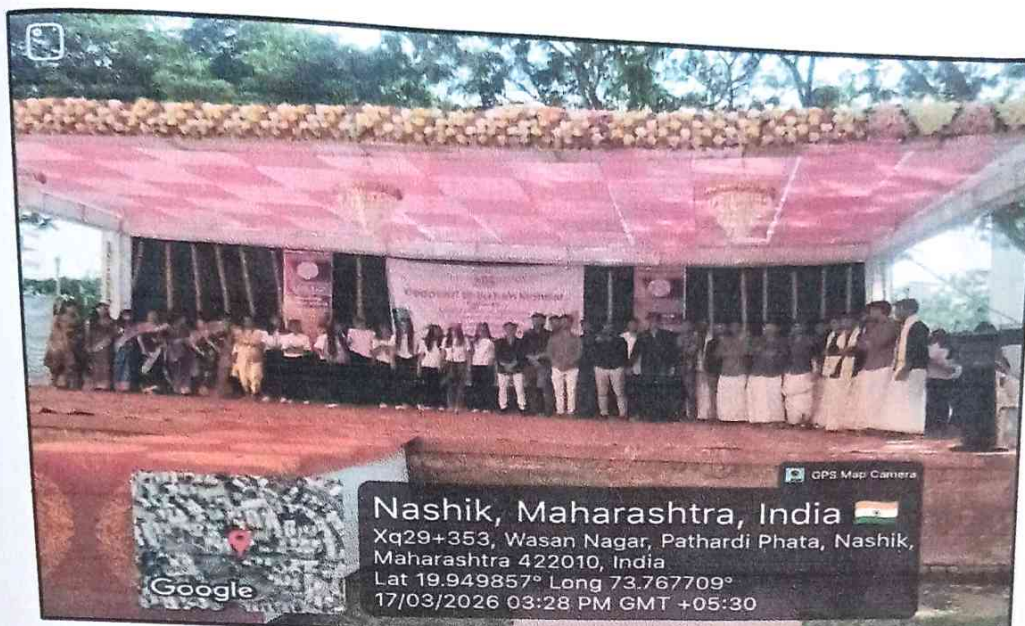
Day-3 Bollywood/Mismatch Day




